Planning Commission Minutes
October 18, 2010

Co-Chairperson Snellback called the meeting to order at 7:02 PM. The following members were present: Howard and Callis. McCorkle was absent. Interim Planning Director James was also present.

Howard moved to approve the minutes of the October 4, 2010 commission meeting. Callis seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Discussion on Future Street Map

Snellback stated she brought all the maps with her. James stated she did meet with Administrator Schmidt and he emphasized the fact that the proposed map in large reflects existing future street locations. There was discussion about the roads on the west side of town off of Highway #410 going south to 112th and north to Hinkleman. Howard stated the question that came up in the last meeting was whether we can widen the north/south street west of Walt and Vern's and east of the Storage Facility. James stated she didn't ask Administrator Schmidt a specific location, but his response in general was we need one place north and south. He wasn't really concerned exactly where. Howard stated what they are looking at is a road that would run north to south from Highway #410 to 112th that would cut between the Buckley Business Park and the Kuehn properties and the Johanson and the Bodle properties. Snellback stated if they are looking for a road that would run north to south from Hinkleman to Highway #410 that would be between Interwest Development and the White River School District bus garage. The commission then had a lengthy discussion about McNeeley and roads going through from Collins to Ryan. Howard stated his recommendation would be if the City investigates and finds that we can either run the proposed street all the way from Hinkleman Rd to 112th, or it needs to be run with a jog, then his proposal is that it be represented on the draft with the McNeeley extension remaining and then we can look at that map as a proposed final Future Street Map. After further discussion the commission agreed the road they want is the line farthest west and runs north/south on

the 2010 street plan key map. Howard stated for his curiosity, he would like to have staff look at extending Rainier Street south to Ryan Road.

The next scheduled meeting will be November 1, 2010.
