
Contract: Hearing Examiner:

Mayor Johnson said we only have one item on our meeting agenda and that is for acceptance of a contract for a hearing examiner. If the Council approves this contract, the hearing examiner will be Millie Judge of the Bear Creek Law Firm. **Council member Boyle Barrett moved to approve the contract for hearing examiner to Millie Judge. Council member Weigelt seconded the motion.** Mayor Johnson said on Friday she and City Attorney Olbrechts interviewed five candidates who had applied for the position of hearing examiner. We had a set number of questions that we asked, and then at the end of our set of questions City Attorney Olbrechts asked each one some legal, technical questions about land use. Mayor Johnson said when all was said and done and she went over her notes to decide who she was going to hire, the City Attorney pretty much left it up to her. Mayor Johnson explained the interview process and gave a brief description of the candidates and how they answered the questions. Council member Twardoski asked if we have a provision to fire this person. Mayor Johnson said this is a temporary position. Her fee is \$135 per hour. Reed reminded everyone that these costs are pass-through. City Administrator Schmidt said she will bill the City each month and we will pass that cost on to whoever the applicant is. **Motion carried.**
