### Determination of Non-Significance (DNS)

**Publish date: December 21, 2016**

#### Code amendment: environmentally sensitive areas

**Project Description:** The city is amending its environmentally sensitive areas codes to comply with requirements at the state and federal levels. The proposed ordinance will amend Chapters 12.08, 12.09, 12.10, 12.11, 12.12, and 12.13 of the Buckley Municipal Code.

**Project Location:** The City of Buckley is about four square miles (4 sq. mi.) within portions of Sections 33, 34, and 35 of Township 20, Range 2E, and portions of Sections 4, 10, and 11 of Township 19, Range 2E, and all of Sections 2 and 3 of Township 19, Range 2E.

**Project Proponent:** City of Buckley.

**Lead agency:** City of Buckley.

The lead agency for this proposal has determined that it does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C.030 (2)(c). This decision was made after review of a completed environmental checklist and other information on file with the lead agency. This information is available to the public on request.
