STUDY SESSION

TUESDAY, July 7, 2015

ATTENDEES: Councilmembers Tremblay, Sundstrom, Rose, Montgomery, Howard and Boyle Barrett. Also in attendance were Mayor Johnson, City Planner Thompson, City Clerk Starr, IT Manager Loye, IT Assistant Frazier and Police Chief Arsanto.

Mayor Pro Tem Boyle Barrett called the Study Session to order at 7:28 PM.

Mayor Pro Tem Boyle Barrett opened the meeting by introducing City Planner Thompson to give a presentation to the Council on the updated Comprehensive Plan and changes to the zoning maps. After a lengthy presentation and discussion, the Council discussed additional days all members would be available to go over the plan with Thompson in more detail and with more discussion. The Council decided to have a Study Session following both the July 14th and July 28th Council meetings to further discuss this issue.

IT Manager Loye and IT Assistant Frazier handed out new lap tops to all Council members, and gave a brief presentation and training session on the operation of the new lap tops.

Council member Howard opened the discussion on the Dangerous Dog Ordinance and let the Council know what he would like to see changed within the current ordinance. After a lengthy discussion and Council members stating their positions on this issue, Council referred this matter back to the Admin, Finance & Public Safety Committee to work on it and bring a new ordinance back to the Council for review and approval by September.
