City's Legislative Agenda



Dangerous Dogs

Mayor Pro Tem Boyle Barrett informed the Council that past minutes on this subject reflect that Council referred this issue back to the Admin, Finance & Public Safety Committee, and tasked that Committee with reviewing the language and bringing a new ordinance back to the full Council for review. After a short discussion, most Council members seemed to lean towards removing breed specific language and working on tightening up the dangerous dog language. Council member Howard said he would like to see this come back before the end of the year. Mayor Pro Tem Boyle Barrett said she would try but there are no guarantees because we are in the middle of budget season.
