

CITY COUNCIL WORKSHOP

TUESDAY, JANUARY 4, 2011

Mayor Johnson called the workshop to order at 6:42 PM.


In attendance were Council members Twardoski, McNally, Montgomery, Patson and Boyle Barrett. Council member Harple was absent. Also in attendance was City Administrator Schmidt. Mayor Pro Tem Reed arrived at 7:05 PM.

Mayor Johnson recommended postponing the agenda item "Impact Fees" to give Council member McNally time to gather additional information. Council member McNally stated that he would like this agenda item to come back to the next workshop. A short discussion ensued regarding when impact fees are paid and what our thresholds are. The Streets & Utilities Committee agreed to look at this issue as well, including the possibility of having two different storm event policies, one for moving stormwater out of the City (main trunk – 100 year storm event) and another 25 year storm event for the feeder lines coming into the City.


City Council Rules & Procedures

There was a lengthy discussion regarding the Council's objectives in developing this document, followed by a line item by line item discussion of Sections 1, 2 and 3. Mayor Pro Tem Reed said what he is hearing is that the Council wants the following: (1) an easy reference guide defining authorities and procedures; (2) identifying rights and responsibilities; (3) smoother City Council meetings; and (4) smoother Council operations. The Finance & Public Safety Committee agreed to take a closer look at RCW 35A.11.20.
