

**City Council Special Meeting
July 12, 2023**

Mayor Burkett called the specially scheduled meeting to order at 6:00 PM.

Upon roll call the following members were present: Smith, Rose, Burbank, Green, Arsanto, and Anderson.

Also present were: City Administrator Brunell, Public Works Director Banks, Police Chief Alfano, Police Records Clerk Burkett, Court Administrator Cash (via Zoom), and City Clerk Percival.

The applicants that were present were Milt Tremblay, Connie Bender, Denice Bergerson, and Maureen Sundstrom.

MAIN AGENDA

Each applicant was given ten minutes to introduce themselves and answer the following questions:

1. Why do you want to serve on the City Council?
2. What experiences, talents or skills do you bring to the City Council community that you would like to highlight?
3. Are there any regional issues or forums in which you have a particular interest or expertise? (e.g. transportation, water supply, human services, water quality, fiscal management, solid waste, parks & open spaces, etc.)
4. Do you want to serve on the City Council because of a particular local issue on which you want to work or are your interests more broadly distributed?

Upon each applicant introducing themselves and answering the questions, Council went into Executive Session to discuss the candidates.

Council retreated into Executive Session at 6:32 for five minutes.

Council returned from Executive Session and reconvened the Council meeting at 6:37 PM.


