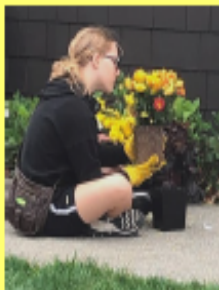


“Many hands make light work!”
