BUCKLEY SPRING CLEANUP

APRIL 12-16, 2021

This year Buckley's Annual Residential Spring Cleanup Program will be held April 12th through April 16th, 2021. Murrey's Disposal and the City Shop Crew will jointly sponsor this year's program. **Please see below for cleanup details.**

You will be allowed three extra bags of garbage (up to 32 gallons). Please do not use personal garbage cans as we cannot be responsible if lost or damaged. Please ensure each bag does not exceed 40 lbs. These will be picked up on **THURSDAY**, your normal garbage day. All extras must be placed in a securely tied 32-gallon bag next to your garbage cart.

You will also be allowed three extra bags of yard waste **ONLY IF YOU PAY FOR YARD WASTE SERVICE**. Please do not put the yard waste in plastic bags because plastic is a contaminant in the composting process. Use biodegradable lawn waste bags (available at the hardware store). Please do not use personal garbage cans as we cannot be responsible if lost or damaged. Place all the extras next to your yard waste container. Try to keep the yard waste clearly separated from the garbage. Each container must weigh less than 40 lbs.

The last item allowed is a major appliance. The only appliances collected this year will be a refrigerator, freezer, range, dishwasher, trash compactor, washing machine, dryer, microwave, hot water tank or air conditioner. Televisions, BBQ's and small appliances will not be accepted. The major appliances will be collected by a separate truck and recycled. **PLEASE PUT THEM IN FRONT OF THE HOUSE, APPLIANCES WILL NOT BE PICKED UP IN THE ALLEY.** We can only accept one appliance per household.

Appliances will be picked up on service day only, please have out by 7:00am on your regular service day.
