NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Buckley Planning Commission will conduct a public hearing on **Monday, 7/19/21 at 7 pm** in the Multipurpose Center Hearing Room at 811 Main St. in Buckley. An option to join the hearing virtually via phone or Zoom will also be posted on the city website notice page the Thursday before the hearing and via the contact below. The Planning Commission will consider a recommendation to City Council on establishment of a Food Trucks Pilot Program which sets clearer guidelines and a streamlined process for permitting food trucks throughout the City of Buckley. This proposal is SEPA exempt.

All interested persons may provide oral or written comments or testimony at or prior to the hearing. Written comments must be submitted by 4 pm on Thursday, 7/15/21 to Buckley City Hall at 933 Main Street; mailed to PO Box 1960, Buckley, WA 98321; or emailed to the contact below. Any person may request a copy of the decision once made, and persons with standing may appeal the final decision pursuant to BMC Title 20. A copy of the staff report, draft Food Trucks Pilot Program guidelines, all applicable review criteria, and all documents and evidence relied upon for the Planning Commission's recommendation are available for examination and inspection, at no cost, in the Buckley Building and Planning Office located in the Buckley Multipurpose Center at 811 Main Street, Buckley, WA 98321.
