The 2.1-acre project site is located at 27815 Highway 410 (APN 56650000291, 56650000292 & 56650000270). Driveways would access SR 410 and Mundy Loss Road. The project will include sidewalks along SR 410 and along Mundy Loss Road. There are no critical areas, shorelines or floodplains on site. The project will include a proposed retail park with a cannabis retail building, a specialty retail building and a coffee stand. The proposal will utilize existing excess capacity within the City's stormwater pond located along the north property boundary of the site. The project will include a 5' perimeter landscape buffer along the north and east boundaries, street trees along the west boundary fronting Mundy Loss Road, enhanced landscaping along SR 410 and parking lot landscaping.
