

CITY OF BUCKLEY NOTICE: SEPA DETERMINATION OF NON-SIGNIFICANCE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Buckley has issued a Determination of Non-Significance (DNS) for the adoption of amended parking facilities in the Historic Commercial Zoning District and the Downtown Design Review Overlay District. The proposed ordinance will reduce or eliminate the need to construct new facilities for most users in these areas. This zoning code amendment is considered a non-project action under the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA). The project proponent and lead agency is the City of Buckley; PO Box 1960, Buckley WA 98321.

The lead agency for this proposed non-project action has determined that it does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C.030(2)(c). This decision was made after review of a completed environmental checklist and other information on file with the lead agency. This information is available to the public on request. This DNS is issued under WAC 197-11-340(2); the lead agency will not act on this proposal for 14 days from the date of this notice.

Written comments or appeals must be received by the responsible official by 4:00 pm, February 4, 2023. You should be prepared to make specific factual objections.
