



CITY OF BUCKLEY NOTICE OF APPLICATION & SEPA DETERMINATION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, on 9/14/23, the City of Buckley SEPA Responsible Official has issued a State Environmental Policy Act Determination of Non-Significant Impact (DNS) for the City's Foothills Trail parking lot project at the corner of SR 410 and Jefferson Avenue in Buckley. The project will construct a 21-standard stall parking lot with two handicap stalls and two future electric vehicle charging stalls. Other improvements include an asphalt driveway connection to Jefferson Avenue, a connection to the Foothills Trail, a bioswale for stormwater treatment, a prefabricated 2-hole restroom building with a drinking fountain, and a light pole.

The City of Buckley, as lead agency, has determined that this proposal will not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C.030(2)(c). This decision was made after review of a SEPA checklist and other supporting information that can be made available to the public on request. This DNS is issued under WAC 197-11-340; the lead agency will not act on this proposal for 14 days from the date of notice publishing. Comments and administrative appeals must be submitted by 5 pm on 10/19/23. This DNS may be appealed by filing an application with the point of contact below within 21 days of this SEPA determination pursuant to BMC 12.04.160 and the timing and procedures set forth in Title 20 BMC.
