




CITY OF BUCKLEY NOTICE OF APPLICATION & SEPA DETERMINATION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, on 12/27/23, the City of Buckley SEPA Responsible Official has issued a State Environmental Policy Act Determination of Non-Significant Impact (DNS) for the City's Bevlo Street Improvements project. The project will include a new detention pond and approximately 500 feet of road and pedestrian connections. This will consist of two 11-foot travel lanes, one 8 foot parallel parking lane on the west side, and back-in angled parking on the east side. Pedestrian facilities include 6-foot sidewalks on both sides of the road.

The City of Buckley, as lead agency, has determined that this proposal will not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C.030(2)(c). This decision was made after review of a SEPA checklist and other supporting information that can be made available to the public on request. This DNS is issued under WAC 197-11-340; the lead agency will not act on this proposal for 14 days from the date of notice publishing. Comments and administrative appeals must be submitted by 5 pm on 1/10/24. This DNS may be appealed by filing an application with the point of contact below within 21 days of this SEPA determination pursuant to BMC 12.04.160 and the timing and procedures set forth in Title 20 BMC.
