

CITY OF BUCKLEY, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 01-21

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BUCKLEY, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON,
AMENDING SECTION 1.04.020 (PENALTIES) OF THE BUCKLEY CITY CODE TO
CORRESPOND WITH RCW 9A.20.021.

WHEREAS, the City's Taxes, Rates & Fees Schedule is to be reviewed by the City Council prior to approval; and

WHEREAS, review by Court staff revealed a discrepancy between the City Code and the Revised Code of Washington regarding the definition of a gross misdemeanor; and

WHEREAS, the City Code cannot not have a stricter penalty regarding maximum penalties for crimes;

NOW THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BUCKLEY, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON,
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 1.04.020 of the Buckley Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

1) Gross Misdemeanor. Every person convicted of a gross misdemeanor shall, unless otherwise specified, be punished by a fine not to exceed \$5,000 or by confinement in jail for a term not to exceed 364 days or by both such fine and confinement.


(2) Misdemeanor. Every person convicted of a misdemeanor shall, unless otherwise specified, be punished by a fine not to exceed \$1,000 or by confinement in jail for a term not to exceed 90 days or by both such fine and confinement.

(3) Civil Infraction. Unless otherwise specified, a civil infraction is punishable by a maximum penalty of \$250.00 not including statutory assessments. (Ord. 19-07 § 1, 2007; Ord. 04-05 § 1, 2005).

Section 2. **Severability.** If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 3. **Effective Date.** This Ordinance or a summary thereof consisting of the title shall be published in the official newspaper of the City and shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after publication.


