RESOLUTION NO. 22-04

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BUCKLEY, WASHINGTON,
DECLARING THE ADOPTION OF THE ANNUAL DOCKET OF
PROPOSED ANNUAL COMPREHENSIVE PLAN AMENDMENT(S)
CONSISTENT WITH ANNUAL COMPREHENSIVE PLAN
AMENDMENT PROCESSES IN BMC 19.06.**

WHEREAS, under the Washington State Growth Management Act cities are allowed annual updates to their comprehensive plans; and

WHEREAS, the City of Buckley received one, city-initiated application (attached to this resolution) for an annual comprehensive plan amendment in 2022; a proposal to revise the methodology by which the City calculates its traffic impact fees (TIFs) as described in Buckley's comprehensive plan Transportation Element; and

WHEREAS, BMC 19.06 specifies the processes for establishing and adopting an annual docket of annual comprehensive plan amendments; and

WHEREAS, the annual comprehensive plan amendment process requires Council adoption of the annual comprehensive plan amendment docket by no later than June 1; and

WHEREAS, after adoption of the annual comprehensive plan amendment docket by Council, for each proposed comprehensive plan amendment BMC 19.06.070 requires a Planning Commission recommendation by no later than September 15 and a decision by City Council by no later than December 15 of the current year; and

WHEREAS, the Buckley Director of Building & Planning reviewed and recommends that Council adopt the 2022 annual comprehensive plan amendment docket with the one and only application received, for the city-proposed TIF methodology update; and

**THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BUCKLEY HEREBY RESOLVES AS
FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The Buckley City Council hereby adopts the Planning Director-recommended annual docket for the 2024 Comprehensive Plan Update, which includes the attached city-initiated proposal to revise the city's TIF methodology.
