RESOLUTION NO. 21-11

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BUCKLEY, WASHINGTON. AUTHORIZING COUNCILMEMBER BRANDON GREEN TO SERVE AS A VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTER AND TO RECEIVE THE SAME COMPENSATION, INSURANCE, AND OTHER BENEFITS AS ARE APPLICABLE TO OTHER VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTERS IN THE CITY OF BUCKLEY.

WHEREAS, RCW 35A.11.110 permits the legislative body of any code city to authorize any of its members to serve as volunteer firefighters, volunteer ambulance personnel, or reserve law enforcement officers, and to receive the same compensation, insurance, and other benefits as are applicable to other volunteer firefighters, volunteer ambulance personnel, or reserve law enforcement officers employed by the city of resolution adopted by a two-thirds vote; NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BUCKLEY, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Pursuant to RCW 35A.11.110, the City Council hereby authorizes Councilmember Brandon Green to serve as a volunteer firefighter and to receive the same compensation, insurance, and other benefits as are applicable to other volunteer firefighters employed by the City of Buckley. City Councilmember Green's previous service as a volunteer firefighter is hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 2. The City Council's authorization and ratification as provided in Section1 of the Resolution is approved by two-thirds vote of the full City Council.

Section 3. The Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.
