NOTICE UTILITY RATE CHANGES FOR 2021

After review and adoption of the City's 2021 Budget the City Council has made the following changes to utility rates for 2021.

Water:

To adequately fund operations and capital replacement adjustments for basic service will increase by 5.0% for all meter sizes.

Water rates and charges

- A. 1. For the base (minimum) service, including water usage from zero to 200 cubic feet per month according to meter size and location within the corporate limits of the city:
