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RE: City of Buckley 2020 Consolidated Utilities Project

The City of Buckley has recently awarded the Capital Improvement Project titled, 2020 Consolidated Utilities to Rodarte Construction Company.

This Contract provides for three schedules of work.

Schedule A – Water Mains provides for the replacement of 380 LF of 8-inch main on Edith from Park to Dundass and the installation of 760 LF of 8-inch main on McNeely from Collins to Mason.

Schedule B – Sanitary Sewer Mains provides for the installation of 760 LF of 12-inch main on McNeely from Collins to Mason, and the replacement of 630 LF of 8-inch main on Spiketon from south of Mountain View to North A Street.

Schedule C – Road Improvements Dieringer Traffic Calming, Collins Road Restoration east of McNeely, Miscellaneous Sidewalk and ADA Ramp Replacements, Foothills Trail Repair (replace 150 LF of asphalt trail), Copperwynd Development Road Repairs, Miscellaneous Catch Basin Repairs, 3rd Street and Dundass Avenue Storm Improvements, 1429 Mason Avenue Sidewalk and Catch Basin Improvements, and Spiketon Road Improvements from south of Mountain View Avenue to Ryan Road (curb, gutter, parking lanes, lane widening, and sidewalk on both sides).

As you can tell by reading through the schedules of work above, there are a lot of different types of work being performed in many different locations throughout the City. Due to the spread-out nature of this project it can sometimes be very difficult to schedule work accurately, making public notification more difficult.

The current project work schedule and map can be found on the City's website. Please keep in mind that schedules can change for various reasons at a moments notice. The City will try and update any changes as quickly as possible.

While both the City and contractor understand that construction can be somewhat disruptive, we hope that each of you benefit from the long-term enhancement of this project. We will work as swiftly as possible to ensure the least amount of disruption.
