

## **Renewing a CPL**

You may apply to renew a license up to 90 days prior to its expiration date. If your license is between one- and 90-days past expiration, you may submit a Late Renewal Application. Any license which is expired by more than 90 days cannot be renewed; an application for an Original License would be required. Military personnel who were unable to renew on time as a result of out-of-state deployment/assignment may qualify for an exemption to the 90-day renewal time limit. Applicants must apply within 90 days of returning to Washington state and provide proof of deployment/assignment dates.

### **Renew by Mail**

You may now renew a CPL – or apply for a replacement CPL – by mail. Send a completed application, a copy of your valid I.D., and payment (check or money order only) to:

## **Receiving Your CPL**

If your application is approved, the Buckley Police Department will mail your CPL to you.

If your application is denied, you will receive a letter informing you of the reason(s) for denial along with information on how to appeal the denial. If you have lost your firearm rights, you may petition the court of record where you reside or where the conviction occurred for the restoration of your rights. Out-of-state convictions are more complex when it comes to restoration of your rights; you may wish to consult an attorney for advice or assistance.
