Mayor Pro-Tem Boyle Barrett opened the meeting at 7:07 PM.

The following members were present from the Planning Commission: Harris and Wink. The following Council members were present: Boyle Barrett, Howard, Montgomery, Rose and Leggett. Also in attendance were Mayor Johnson, City Administrator Schmidt, City Planner Thompson and the UW Students from the Master of Urban Planning Class.

The UW students presented information to the Planning Commission and Council on what they have been working on for the 410 Corridor based on public meetings and discussion with City officials. They presented three different sketches and asked for feedback on each.

The group then did a round table project putting different ideas together as to what they would like to see on the different areas of the 410 corridor. After the round table everyone gave their input as to their thoughts and ideas.

The next meeting will be June 4, 2013 and the students will present their findings to the Council on both the 410 Corridor and the WSU property.

City Administrator Schmidt stated that the Council needs to have a meeting prior to July 23, 2013 to discuss what we are going to do over water supply. The utility committee will be looking at this first and then it will come back to the full Council, but we need to have a decision made prior to July 23, 2013. The meeting will be tentatively scheduled as a Special Council Meeting on July 16, 2013.
