Council Rules and Procedures:

Council decided they would rather come up with City Council guidelines instead of moving forward with a council rules and procedures ordinance.

ARPA Funding:


City Administrator Schmidt gave an overview of questions that businesses and groups have had regarding ARPA fund spending. He explained that the finance dept. cannot allot any money until the Council decides how to spend the money with documentation. One thing to consider with businesses is if they were affected directly by Covid-19. The ARPA funds need to be allocated by 2024 and spent by 2026. Another thing for Council to consider is City of Buckley Police Dept. needs body cams and public safety is approved by ARPA funding.

City Council would like to have a Special City Council Study Session on March 29, 2022, to discuss ARPA funding more.
