

CITY COUNCIL

STUDY SESSION

March 1, 2016

ATTENDEES: Councilmembers Sundstrom, Rose, Burkett, Leggett, Tremblay, Kyllonen and Boyle Barrett. Also in attendance were Recreational Services Director Boyd and Mayor Johnson.

Mayor Pro Tem Tremblay called the Study Session to order at 7:00 PM.

Mayor Pro Tem Tremblay opened the Study Session with the discussion of potential RCO Grant projects. Recreational Services Director Boyd gave a short presentation on potential projects that she was planning on submitting for RCO Grants. The Council discussed the few topics she presented and Recreational Services Director Boyd will take those comments into consideration.

Mayor Johnson stated that there was no updated information at this time on the manganese issue in the City's water, but they should have most tests back and will give an update at the next scheduled Council meeting.

Mayor Pro Tem Tremblay asked each Council member what projects or ideas they had in mind personally that they would like to see the City of Buckley use monies from the sale of the gas system for. Each Council member gave an idea they had in mind and the Council will be discussing these ideas in detail at another Study Session.

Council member Sundstrom made a statement that he would like to keep receiving his council packets in paper and not electronically. Mayor Johnson stated that he will still be able to receive his council packets in paper form, but the City is going to be slowly transitioning to electronic packets.

Mayor Pro Tem Tremblay stated he would like to add the Dangerous Dog Ordinance discussion to the next Study Session and Council member Boyle Barrett is going to think of sample survey questions, referring to the survey to be sent out with utility bills for citizens of Buckley to provide their feedback.

The Study Session adjourned at 8:15 PM.
