City Council Vacancy


Mayor Pro Tem Tremblay opened the Study Session with a review of the City's current procedure for filling a vacant Council seat. He reviewed the procedure adopted in Resolution No. 14-07 with Council members. After a lengthy discussion regarding the process and timelines, Council agreed to make no changes to the current procedure; however, there is a slight wording change required in the Resolution that can be corrected at a later date. Council members will submit their questions for the candidates to the Mayor as soon as possible.

Impact Fee Incentives

Mayor Pro Tem Tremblay stated that this has been discussed in the Transportation & Utilities Committee and shared what the Committee would like to see changed. After a lengthy discussion, Mayor Pro Tem Tremblay listed the four points they would like to send forward to the City Administrator. They are (1) Not transferable; (2) Time Limit on Return; (3) Adequate Revenue to Replace the Loss; and (4) Period of time.

Council member Sundstrom moved to adjourn. Council member Rose seconded the motion. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:51 PM.
