Mayor Johnson called the regularly scheduled meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

Upon roll call the following members were present: Bender, Smith, B. Burkett, Wilbanks, Tremblay, and S. Burkett. Also present were City Administrator Schmidt, Police Chief Arsanto, Asst. Police Chief Northam, Fire Chief Predmore, Asst. Chief Skogen, and Planning Asst. Evans.

Council member Smith moved to Authorize the Mayor to Execute the Interagency Agreement between the City of Buckley and Washington State Patrol regarding Mobilization under the Washington State Fire Services Resources Mobilization Plan. Council member Tremblay seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Community Services:


Council member S. Burkett stated that their next meeting is scheduled from July 18th at 1:00 PM at City Hall.
