

BUCKLEY SPRING CLEANUP

APRIL 9-12, 2018

This year Buckley's Annual Residential Spring Cleanup Program will be held April 9th through April 12th, 2018. D.M. Disposal Service and the City Shop Crew will jointly sponsor this year's program. The program will work the same as in years past. **Please read below.**

All items will be collected curbside where your normal garbage is picked up on **WEDNESDAY**. Have them at the site by 7:00 AM on pickup day.

You will be allowed three extra bags or containers of garbage. Please have up to three extra bags or cans sitting next to each other and set slightly apart from the other items so the driver can easily distinguish them. Please remember that there is a weight restriction of 45 lbs. per container.

You will also be allowed three extra containers of yard waste **ONLY IF YOU PAY FOR YARD WASTE SERVICE**. Please do not put the yard waste in plastic bags because plastic is a contaminant in the composting process. Use cardboard boxes or an extra garbage can. The yard waste must not be longer than three feet in length and must be bundled. Place all the extra containers next to your yard waste container. Try to keep the yard waste clearly separated from the garbage. Each container must weigh less than 45 lbs.

The last item allowed is a major appliance. This could be a refrigerator, freezer, range, dishwasher, trash compactor, washing machine, dryer or hot water heater. **Microwave ovens, televisions and small appliances will not be accepted.** The major appliances will be collected by a separate truck and recycled. **PLEASE PUT THEM IN FRONT OF THE HOUSE, APPLIANCES WILL NOT BE PICKED UP IN THE ALLEY.** We can only accept one appliance per household.

Appliances will be picked up all week so if you have an appliance, please put it out on Monday.

NOTICE UTILITY RATE CHANGES FOR 2018

After review and adoption of the City's 2018 Budget the City Council has made the following changes to utility rates for 2018.

Water:

To adequately fund operations and capital replacement adjustments for basic service will increase by 5.0% for all meter sizes and consumption rates for all usage tiers by 1.5% as follows:

Water rates and charges

A. 1. For the base (minimum) service, including water usage from zero to 200 cubic feet per month according to meter size and location within the corporate limits of the city:

2. Users outside the city limits shall pay the monthly charges set forth in subsections A(1) and B(1) of this section plus a surcharge of 20 percent of the total charge.

B. 1. For usage above 200 cubic feet, the following rates are imposed for each 100 cubic feet of usage according to location within or without the corporate limits of the city:

Stormwater Utility:

To adequately fund operations and capital replacement adjustments a 3.0% increase in the rates for the stormwater utility is needed as follows:

Storm Sewer Monthly Service Charge	2018

*ESU for Storm Sewer calculation is defined to mean 8,000 square feet of impervious surface area or 1 SFR

Solid Waste (Garbage):

Due to changes to service by introduction of the various cart containers in 2016, the restructuring of the rates more adequately reflect customer behavior and fair pricing. Therefore rates for cart sizes 10 – 96 gallon will be adjusted by an increase of up to 7% for three sizes and reductions of up to -10.3% for two sizes, an increase in rates for extra pickups by 25% and all other service categories by 2.5% to reflect the increase in contractual services and County tipping fees as follows.
