NOTICE OF GARBAGE RATE INCREASE

Due to volatility in the “well publicized” global recycling markets and continued loss of revenue, D.M. Disposal exercised their right under the current Collection Service Agreement to seek a rate adjustment to offset the significant and unforeseen increase in costs that they’ve experienced as a result of regulations associated with contaminated recycling.

D.M. Disposal is seeking to recover approximately \$4,000/mo in increased costs, which calculates to an increase in the rates to the City of 10.92% for each residential service classification 10 gallon thru 96 gallon containers. The new rates to the City take effect July 1, 2018.

In order to absorb this increase in service costs the City analyzed the impact and determined that City rates for the same customer classifications need to be increased by 7.5% in order to maintain operational levels within the budget. The City Council approved this new 7.5% rate increase on June 12, 2018, which will take effect on August 1, 2018. Services fees subject to the increase are highlighted in the table on page 2.

WEDNESDAY August 8th– **The Coats** –Nationally touring artists, The Coats are the Pacific Northwest's premiere a cappella band


