July 26th– **Buddy, Ritchie & the Bopper Show**– Going back in time to the 50’s to the day the music died! Get your toes tapping!


August 2nd– **John Hoover and the Mighty Quinn's**–The Mighty Quinn’s perform a tribute to the songs, music and spirit of John Denver.


