

Entry Level Police Officer Qualifications 2018:

Minimum Qualifications:

- High School diploma or equivalent; additional education or training in law enforcement is desirable
 - Minimum age of 21
 - U.S. Citizen
- Possession of a valid Washington State Driver's License
 - No prior felony convictions
 - No major traffic violations in the past five years
- Must meet medical and physical ability test standards
- Successful completion of one year probationary period
 - Must pass minimum testing:

Testing consist of written exam, oral board, polygraph, psychological and extensive background investigation. The Civil Service Commission reserves the right to reject applications on the basis of information contained in the application or upon background investigation findings.

- Obtain Washington State Peace Officer Certification within 1 year
