Mayor Johnson called the regularly scheduled meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

Upon roll call the following members were present: Tremblay, Sundstrom, Rose, Leggett, Boyle Barrett, and Montgomery. Also in attendance were City Administrator Schmidt, Fire Chief Predmore, IT & Communications Manager Loye, Police Chief Arsanto, and Assistant Police Chief Northam. **Council member Montgomery moved to excuse council member Howard. Council member Rose seconded the motion. Motion carried.**

STAFF REPORTS Mayor Johnson stated that tonight we will swear in two new Police Officers and one new Assistant Fire Chief. Mayor Johnson proceeded to administer the Oath of Office to Officer Arthur Fetter and Officer Christopher Berg, as well as Assistant Fire Chief Eric Skogen.

City Administrator Schmidt updated the Council on the Water Transmission Main. The main is still inoperable; we believe that the leak is in the creek. Once the water levels get low enough we think we will be able to put a temporary band on it.

Police Chief Arsanto stated that when he presented the salary portion of the Budget he didn't include Officer Fetter attending academy. Chief Arsanto plans on keeping Tim Personius on the road while Fetter is attending academy and will be able to get these wages reimbursed through the State.

Fire Chief Predmore reminded the Council to RSVP for the annual Fire Banquet if you are planning to attend.
