NEW FIREWORKS DISCHARGE RULES GO INTO EFFECT FOR THE 4TH OF JULY

Due to the high volume of complaints from the citizens of Buckley over the discharge of fireworks and the number of days that fireworks were allowed to be discharged, the Buckley City Council voted to allow the discharge of fireworks on July 4th ONLY from 9:00 am until midnight.
