

Lateral Police Officer Qualifications 2018:

Minimum Qualifications:

- Minimum 21 years of age
- High School diploma
- Valid Washington state driver's license
- U.S. Citizen
- No felony arrest convictions
- Ability to read, write and speak the English language fluently
- Must be willing to work various shifts to include nights, holidays, weekends, and on call as required.
- Must have excellent communications skills and ability to make decisions during stressful situations.
- Out of state applicants require obtaining Washington State Peace Officer Certification within three months.
- Possession of Washington State Peace Officer Certification
- Successful completion of one year minimum probationary period

Testing Procedures:

- The testing procedures may consist of but not limited to an oral board, polygraph test, physiological test, physical examination with drug screening, extensive background check and Chief's interview.
