Harvest Rain for Your Yard & Garden!

While winter and spring rains bring plenty of moisture, there is still value in being able to harvest and store our abundant rainfall to use during the periodic and seasonal dry times in the Pacific Northwest. Rain barrels are an easy way to capture some of that rain and put it to use in your yard, garden, or home!

Sponsored by the City of Buckley and the Pierce Conservation District, this workshop will cover the history of rain water harvesting and best uses for rain barrel water, and provide guidance to assemble and take home your very own rain barrel (free!), ready for installation under a downspout of your choice!
