ORDINANCE NO. 01-22

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BUCKLEY, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON, AMENDING SECTION 2.04.010 TO UPDATE CITY COUNCIL MEETING TIME.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Buckley currently meets on the second and fourth Tuesday of every month at 7:00 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has discussed the benefits of beginning the meetings at an earlier time; and

WHEREAS, the City Council agrees that holding their meetings at 6:00 p.m. is beneficial to the community;

NOW THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BUCKLEY, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Section 2.04.010 of the Buckley Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

The regular sessions of the city council shall be held in the Multipurpose Center, 811 Main Street, Buckley, Washington, on the second and fourth Tuesdays in each and every month at 6:00 p.m. As necessary to address emergency situations, the city council may by ordinance or resolution change the meeting location. The city council may also by ordinance or resolution hold meetings remotely by phone or by other technological device when and to the extent authorized by state law. As necessary to address emergency situations, the ordinances and resolutions required by this section can be passed at the new meeting location or the first authorized remote meeting as the first order of business. No ordinance or resolution shall be necessary for a change in location or to hold meetings remotely when mandated by state law, including a Governor's proclamation. To the extent that circumstances reasonably permit, the city clerk shall provide reasonable notice of any change in meeting location, including posting on the door of the Multipurpose Center, posting on the city's website and providing notice in the meeting agenda.

Section 2. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance or a summary thereof consisting of the title shall be published in the official newspaper of the City, and shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after publication.
