



**NOTICE OF CITY COUNCIL PUBLIC HEARING  
REGARDING SEWER LATECOMER'S AGREEMENT  
FOR SPIKETON SEWER LIFT STATION**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Buckley City Council has scheduled a Public Hearing shortly after 7:00 PM on **Tuesday, August 25, 2020**, at the Buckley Multipurpose Building at 811 Main Street, Buckley (unless the Governor extends the Open Public Meetings Act Suspension, in which case it will be held via Zoom). The purpose of the Public Hearing is to solicit public input and comment from interested individuals or groups on the City Council's consideration of a Sewer Latecomer's Agreement related to the sanitary sewer lift station constructed as part of the White River Meadows Plat. The purpose of the Agreement is to provide, for a period of not to exceed 20 years, for the reimbursement of such real estate owners or developers and their assigns by any owner of real estate who did not contribute to the actual cost of such water, sewer and/or stormwater and who are located within the assessment area described in the agreement and who subsequently tap into or use the same (the "latecomer").
