

RESOLUTION NO. 15-02

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BUCKLEY, WASHINGTON, DECLARING AS SURPLUS PROPERTY TWO PISTOLS AND AUTHORIZING THEIR DISPOSITION.

WHEREAS, the City of Buckley ("City") would like to declare as surplus property two pistols which were used as duty weapons by the City's current Fire Chief, Alan Predmore, when he served as a Police Sergeant with the Buckley Police Department for twelve years; and

WHEREAS, the two pistols, a SigArms P-230 380 caliber with serial number S142453 and a SigArms P-226 9mm with a serial number U167076, are no longer needed as the City is acquiring new duty weapons for its police officers; and

WHEREAS, each pistol is valued at approximately \$200.00 and \$400.00, respectively; and

WHEREAS, in recognition of Chief Predmore's service with the Buckley Police Department, the City Administrator will dispose of the two pistols via trade for an assault rifle, Colt AR-15 .223 caliber with serial number GC0051054, currently owned by Chief Predmore, which is valued at approximately \$600.00; NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BUCKLEY, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby declares as surplus to the City's needs two pistols, a SigArms P-230 380 caliber with serial number S142453 and a SigArms P-226 9mm with a serial number U167076.

Section 2. The City Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator to dispose of the pistols via trade, as described in the recitals above, and to do so in accordance with all applicable Washington state laws governing transfers of firearms.

Section 3. This resolution will take effect immediately upon passage by the City Council.


