

**CITY OF BUCKLEY, WASHINGTON**

**RESOLUTION NO. 19-01**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BUCKLEY, PIERCE COUNTY, WASHINGTON AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A 2017 FORD TRANSIT WAGON, AND WAIVING THE COMPETITIVE BIDDING REQUIREMENT DUE TO SPECIAL MARKET CONDITIONS.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds that based upon extensive research by the City Administrator that the purchase of a 2017 Ford Transit Wagon is appropriate because there is no used bus of similar size currently available in the Puget Sound area at the price purchased and if the City failed to have immediately purchased the bus it likely would have been purchased by another party; and

**WHEREAS**, RCW 39.04.280 provides that a local agency, by Resolution, may waive the competitive bidding requirement when the purchase involves special facilities or market conditions; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds that there were no other buses available at a similar price and that if it failed to purchase the vehicle the City would likely have had to expend substantially more funds on a similar bus; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council is it appropriate to waive the competitive bidding requirements for the above reasons; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEATAC, WASHINGTON HEREBY RESOLVES as follows:**

1. The City's purchase of the 2017 Ford Transit Wagon is authorized in the amount of \$ \$29,662.56 (including tax), and
2. The competitive bidding requirement for the Ford Transit Wagon is waived as the purchase involves special market conditions.


