WASHINGTON, IN SUPPORT OF THE FOOTHILLS RAILS-TO-TRAILS COALITION,
FOOTHILLS TRAIL HISTORICAL PAVILION DR. TAIT PLAZA

WHEREAS, The Foothills Rails to Trails Coalition would like to build The Foothills Trail Historical Pavilion – Dr. Tait Plaza; and

WHEREAS, the Plaza will speak to the history of the Foothills Trail and the legacy of Dr. Tait who was the town doctor for many years who had a vision of a trail system connecting communities with a trail corridor on the abandoned railroad property and was a founding member of the Foothills Rails to Trails Coalition; and

WHEREAS, the Plaza will provide an inviting open pavilion as a place to gather, learn, and rest next to the Foothills Trail; and

WHEREAS, The Foothills Rails to Trails Coalition has presented their ideas to the Buckley City Council; and

WHEREAS, The City Council acknowledges the importance of this project; and

WHEREAS, The City Council fully supports this project and the Foothills Rails to Trails Coalition seeking funding for this project; and

WHEREAS, the Foothills Rails to Trails Coalition will provide all funding to construct this project; and

WHEREAS, the Foothills Rails to Trails Coalition will be solely responsible for the safety and well being of site during construction; and


WHEREAS, the Foothills Rails to Trails Coalition agrees to provide proper project management throughout construction; and

WHEREAS, The City, in partnership with the Foothills Rails to Trails Coalition, will provide the necessary utilities after the pavilion is constructed.


