NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Buckley Planning Commission will conduct a public hearing on **Monday, June 15, 2020, at 7 p.m.**

The purpose of the hearing is to obtain public input on amendments to the City's Subdivision Code in Buckley Municipal Code Title 18. Proposed amendments are to ensure consistency with Buckley's comprehensive plan and Washington State law, improve the clarity of Title 18 and to incorporate certain efficiencies. The proposed amendments would be adopted as a complete repeal and replacement of Buckley's current subdivision code. A SEPA Determination of Non-Significance (DNS) was issued for this proposed non-project development regulation update on May 27, 2020.

UPDATE: Due to Governor Inslee's updated proclamation 20-28.4, which extended the prohibition on in-person public meetings, **this June 15 subdivision code hearing will now be held by phone and online; not in-person.**

Members of the public are invited to attend the hearing. The City will also accept written public comment until the time of the hearing. All interested persons may provide oral or written comments or testimony at the hearing. Written comments should be delivered to Buckley City Hall at 933 Main Street or PO Box 1960, Buckley, WA 98321. Comments may also be emailed to elewis@cityofbuckley.com. The final decision-making body for this update is the Buckley City Council as described in Buckley Municipal Code Title 20. Any person with standing may appeal the final decision.
